1. Applicant must be part of the PV-Solar Delegation team to Germany, a programme organized by the Malaysian-German Chamber of Commerce & Industry (MGCC). Evidence of confirmed registration with MGCC is required as supporting document.
2. Financial support
 - a. Submit report and invoice to MBIPV Project with supporting document (copy of receipt from MGCC) within 2 weeks after the solar mission trip to Germany. The report should include how the solar mission trip has impacted you and your organization in terms of knowledge and business opportunities.  - b. Report must be submitted to MBIPV Project latest by **Monday, 5th July 2010**. Disbursement of financial incentive will be **forfeited** for report received after 5th July 2010.
 - c. Financial incentive is limited to Ringgit Malaysia Five Thousand (RM5,000.00) per person per organisation. Refund is disbursed upon satisfactory assessment of the report submitted.
 - d. Please note that the financial support is non-negotiable and the incentive is to cover a maximum of ten (10) participants only.
 - e. Priority is given to MBIPV Project's Approved PV Service Provider (APVSP) for the financial incentives. Priority evaluation of financial incentives for APVSPs will close by Friday, 7th May 2010 thereafter the incentives are open to all applicants.
 - f. Priority is also given to the first representative submitted in the application form. The eligibility of the remaining representative submitted by each organization for the financial incentives is at the total discretion of the MBIPV Project based on funds availability.
3. MBIPV Project is committed to the disbursement of financial incentives once on the award is given and report is satisfactorily assessed. However, MBIPV Project shall not be held liable for any consequences arising from the PV-Solar Delegation programme organized by the MGCC.
